
In case of hangup, restart both Modem and Router. The power button is on back of both.

Fire equipment

Fire extinguishers on both floors. In the kitchen you find one together with a Fire blanket in a labelled cabinet.

A fire spray should always be on the kitchen counter. Burn gel is also available. Smoke detectors in all rooms except kitchen.

• Smoke detector outside the kitchen might be triggered in case of excessive steam from cooking. Only one way to stop it, remove battery. (Please don't stand on one of the chairs at the dining table, seats are very weak. Use the brown chair from the kitchen)



Water

Tap water is safe to drink.

There is an alarm in the kitchen for water leaks under the kitchen counter/fridge. Water will automatically turn off in these instances (can occur if an ice cube slides under the fridge for example). If this occurs, there will be a red flash on the sensor in the bottom right corner in the tall cabinet left of the fridge (Picture 1 below). Push the button on the sensor to ignore the alarm.

In case of any water leakage in general:

Main stop valve for water supply is located in the room behind the laundry room (Picture 2 below). This room is not available for AirBnB guests, but it is not locked for you to have access to the main valve in case of a water leak.

TV

TV connected to surround sound system in the living room. There is also a Bluray/DVD player and a Chromecast ("Familiestue") for streaming. To get the surround sound to work the source must be set to "CDR/TAPE" as shown in picture below.

Fireplace

Fireplace in the living room can be used if desired.

Only use dry wood for making the fire.

Never burn anything else, including paper.

GARBAGE

Tromsø municipality has optical garbage disposal using colour coded bags:

Green spotted bag – food waste

Purple spotted bag – clean plastic (plastics with food residue/fats are thrown in general waste)

Blue spotted bag – paper and cardboard

Gray or grocery store bags – General waste

All bags are closed tightly and thrown away in the containers out on the street, as shown in picture below.

Garbage containers outside. Large right container is used for General waste and all sorted trash in colour coded bags.

Glass and metal can be thrown away in container with orange lid.

SNOW/ICE

The road from the mailboxes and to the house is private, but the street has an agreement with someone who removes snow during the midday in case of snow falls. If there is not a car parked in front of the garage, he will remove snow there as well.

There will be a shovel under the entrance roof for shovelling snow in the staircase. There will also be a bucket of sand to sprinkle on slippery ice.

Outdoor equipment

If you have outdoor equipment with you, feel free to use the storage unit right outside the entrance to store it. There is a key to the storage in the red key cabinet besides the entrance in the hallway.

First aid kit

First aid equipment in a black box in mirrored wardrobe in main bedroom.



Bus

Closest bus stop is "Storskogen" on the street above the house. There is also a bus stop called "Nøysomheten" further north. But "Storskogen" is closer.

<u>Bus 20</u> heads south ("Kroken via sentrum") to the city centre and further to the mainland and heads north ("Stakkevollan via UNN") to the university (UiT) and the hospital (UNN).

<u>Bus 24</u> heads south ("Kroken sør via sentrum") to the city centre and further to the mainland and heads north ("Tromsø lufthavn via Mortensnes") to the shopping centre "Jekta" and also directly to the airport.

Download the app "Svipper" for planning routes and purchasing tickets.

If you prefer to walk, it's 15-20 minutes to the city centre.

Grocery stores

Nearest grocery store is Eurospar Kræmer and Kiwi, both on Stakkevollveien. Joker on Dramsveien for store which is open on Sundays.

Reflective items, stingers, umbrellas

In the white boxes in the hallway, you'll find reflective items for walk in the dark. If it's slippery outside you can also use stingers on your shoes. (Please don't walk indoors when on). And there are also some umbrellas available.

Towels for taking away

If you want to take a swim in the sea or visit swimming pool, please use towels from plastic drawers in the laundry room.

DEFICIESIES

Things in the house which should have been fixed, which we are aware of

- Back of mirror door broken in bathroom first floor.
- Broken plug for sink in bathroom first floor.
- Crack on backside of Fireplace. Only cosmetic, no danger.

DEPARTURE

Would greatly appreciate if you remove sheets and bedding from the beds and put on the floor in the laundry room and throw out the trash.

Fireplace instruction

If you're not familiar with making up a fire, follow these steps.



Step 1: Put in 2 larger logs close together.



Step 2: Put bark and igniting bag in between logs.



Step 3: Ignite pad.

Step 5: Shut door with ventilation open. (Button pushed in.)



Step 4: Put 2 lesser logs on top

This should be sufficient for warming up the living room on cold evenings. If you need to feed fire even more, 2 lesser logs or 1 big is enough.
